MINUTES

Tiff thanked the councillors for uploading last week's task onto Seesaw. Some suggestions to improve the mainsite included; more playground equipment for each class, different options/larger meals at lunchtime and snack times, opportunities to join clubs, a wheelchair swing for the playground, longer play times, more access to the flat and school trips and more time with the music man. Carlton suggested the possibility for classes to have lessons to prepare them for later life such as how to pay bills etc. Kexborough suggested having more iPads to use in class and more opportunities to visit mainsite for fun activities. Oakhill suggested more after school clubs, improvements to their outside areas, bean bags for the calm room and a new freezer for the class.

Tiff looked at the suggestions from each class and noticed a common theme across the classes. Most classes mentioned wanting improvements to school dinners such as; more sauces, larger portions, more meals on offer, cheese and crackers returning to the menu. Tiff would like to have a meeting with Linsey, our school cook, to put forward the councillors ideas to improve school dinners. Tiff would like the council to think of 3 questions to ask Lynsey by the next meeting.
